

<b>GENERAL SERVICE - SINGLE PHASE (Optional)</b>	<b>GS - 2</b>
<b>APPLICABLE:</b> To all consumers served single-phase in the State of Wyoming for all uses except irrigation, subject to the established rules and regulations of the Cooperative. Service under this schedule is limited to 50 kVa of transformer capacity. To be eligible for this tariff, the consumer must make a written request to be placed on this rate, and once receiving the rate must remain on the rate for a period of at least one year from the date the change is made.	
<b>CHARACTER OF SERVICE:</b> Single-Phase, 60 cycles, at standard voltages	
<b>RATE:</b>	
Basic Charge:	\$26.00 per consumer per month
Energy Charge: First 1,000 kWh per month	\$0.11310 per kWh per month
All remaining kWh	\$0.10310 per kWh per month
Any adjustments to the base rate above shall be reflected on the Rate Rider Tariff - Sheet 14	
<b>METER READINGS:</b> This account shall be read by the consumer monthly. In the event the consumer fails to read his meter and the Cooperative has to estimate the bill, the following method will be used to adjust the billing when an actual reading is received. The difference between the two actual readings shall be divided equally by the number of billing periods between the readings and calculated on the above listed energy charges.	
<b>MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE:</b> The minimum monthly charge shall be the greater of the following: 1. The minimum monthly charge as specified in the contract for service, or 2. The Basic Charge.	
<b>TEMPORARY SERVICE:</b> Temporary service shall be supplied in accordance with the foregoing charges except that the consumer shall pay in addition to the foregoing charges the total cost of connecting and disconnecting services less the value of material returned to stock. A deposit, in advance, may be required of the full amount of the estimated bill of service, including the cost of connection and disconnection.	
<b>SERVICE PROVISIONS:</b> All wiring, poles, lines and other electrical equipment beyond the metering point shall be considered the distribution system of the consumer and shall be furnished and maintained by the consumer.	
<b>TERMS OF PAYMENT:</b> The above charges are net and become due and payable upon the receipt of the statement. A one and one-half percent (1½%) charge will be added to any outstanding balance due fifteen days from the date of mailing indicated on the billing statement.
