

GENERAL SERVICE - THREE PHASE	GS - 3
<b>APPLICABLE:</b> To all accounts served three-phase for all uses except irrigation and energy development, subject to the established rules and regulations of the Cooperative. Service under this schedule is limited to customers requiring up to 350 kVA of transformer capacity.	
<b>CHARACTER OF SERVICE:</b> Three-Phase, 60 cycles, at standard voltages	
<b>RATE:</b> Basic Charge: \$42.00 per consumer per month Energy Charge: \$0.1127 per kWh per month  Any adjustments to the base rate above shall be reflected on the Rate Rider Tariff Sheet 16.	
<b>SEASONAL SERVICE:</b> Consumers requiring service only during certain seasons, not exceeding nine months per year, shall guarantee a minimum annual charge in which case there shall be no minimum monthly charge. The minimum annual charge shall be twelve (12) times the monthly charge and shall be paid in advance. The energy will be billed at \$0.1240 per kwh and will be billed in January billing for the preceding year usage.	
<b>MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE:</b> The minimum monthly charge shall be the greater of the following: 1. The minimum monthly charge as specified in the contract for service, or 2. A charge of \$1.00 per kVA of installed transformer capacity, or 3. The Basic Charge.	
<b>TEMPORARY SERVICE:</b> Temporary service shall be supplied in accordance with the foregoing charges except that the consumer shall pay in addition to the foregoing charges the total cost of connecting and disconnecting services less the value of material returned to stock. A deposit, in advance, may be required of the full amount of the estimated bill of service, including the cost of connection and disconnection.	
<b>SERVICE PROVISIONS:</b> All wiring, poles, lines and other electrical equipment beyond the metering point shall be considered the distribution system of the consumer and shall be furnished and maintained by the consumer.	
<b>TERMS OF PAYMENT:</b> The above charges are net and become due and payable upon the receipt of the statement. A one and one-half percent (1½%) charge will be added to any outstanding balance due fifteen days from the date of mailing indicated on the billing statement.
