The Wyoming Rural Electric Association, on behalf of rural electric cooperatives in Wyoming, is sponsoring a trip for three high school students to the National Rural Electric Cooperative Association (NRECA) Youth Tour in Washington, DC. The 2023 Youth Tour is June 11-18.

You are eligible to apply for this exciting experience because your parents are members of a Wyoming Electric Cooperative. Besides recognizing youth leadership in Wyoming, our purpose is to educate young people about our Nation's history and electric cooperatives. Information concerning the Youth Tour, the Youth Leadership Council and a proposed itinerary from a previous Youth Tour are attached.

In addition, one of the students selected for the Youth Tour will also be eligible to represent Wyoming as a member of the NRECA Youth Leadership Council (YLC). As one of 41 members of the YLC, this student will attend a leadership conference along with the February/March 2024 NRECA annual meeting.

WREA and NRECA will pay travel, lodging, meals and group excursion expenses. The winner will be responsible for non-essential expenses such as souvenirs.

If you wish to apply, please complete and return the attached forms, <u>along with two letters of recommendation</u>, by **Monday**, **January 20**<sup>th</sup>. Members of the WREA Board of Directors and staff will review the application materials and conduct the interviews. **The interviews will be scheduled for January 25<sup>th</sup> via Zoom.** All of the students interviewed will be contacted with the Committee's decision as soon as possible following the interviews.

We will follow the CDC guidelines for Covid while traveling to and from as well as while we are in Washington DC.

If a student shows signs of Covid 19 while in Washington DC they will be given a rapid test. If that test comes back positive we will take them to a clinic to have a regular test done. While we are waiting on results the student will be quarantined at the hotel. If the regular test comes back positive they will be quarantined until they are cleared for travel back to Wyoming. At

no time will the students be left alone in the hotel. There will always be a chaperone at the hotel with them. Parents will be contacted prior to and after testing.

If a student's roommate test positive the roommate will be moved and we will test the remaining roommates every day for the rest of the trip to make sure they are not positive too.

If we have a worse case scenario and a student needs to be admitted to a hospital while in Washington DC the parents will be contacted immediately and asked to fly out to be with their student.

We will do everything in our power to make this a safe, fun experience for your student. We are working closely with NRECA to ensure this.
