New Statement Format Arriving Soon!

We have been busy updating our billing statement format, which is set to arrive in the next billing cycle. This new layout will contain the same information you already receive, while providing easy-to-locate information such as auto-payment enrollment type, date of auto-payment transaction, and enhanced monthly messages in the 'important information' section. The most visible improvements will be the enhanced color scheme and the relocation of the payment remittance stub, which has been moved from the top section to the bottom of the statement page.

At the office, we continue to see a wide variation in the amount of time between when an item is placed in the mail to the date it arrives at its destination. We also understand that using the postal system is often a preferred method for submitting payments, and is a standard practice for many individuals and businesses. If Wyrulec Company does not receive your mailed payment by the payment deadline, a courtesy reminder notice is mailed to the service address on file. If the past due payment is not resolved by the disclosed deadline, our office will place a courtesy call prior to disconnecting service. Should you receive this mailed notice or call, please contact Wyrulec Company as soon as possible.

The new statement changes will also flow over to our online services at wyrulec.com and to the Wyrulec mobile app. Our digital tools provide members with an enhanced ability to view billing statements early before they arrive by mail, paperless options, enhanced usage history graphs, electronic payment options and more. For enrollment or log-in assistance, stop by the office or give us a call at 877-WYRULEC (877-997-8532). Remember, you can always call to make your payment by telephone at no additional charge. It is our priority to provide you with excellent service and assist you with any questions you may have.
